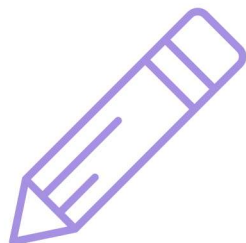

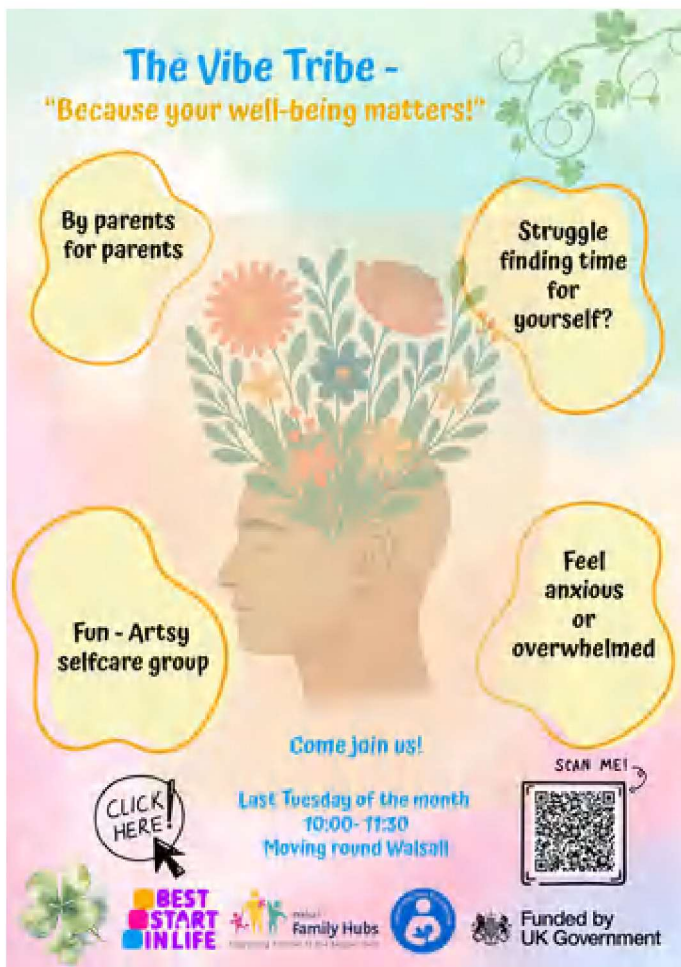

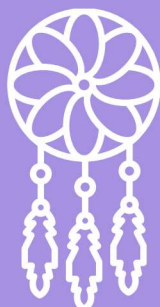

This Summer we have lots of exciting & free activities for children and young people aged 5-16 yrs on income based free-school meals. The portal will be live from June for you to get booked on.

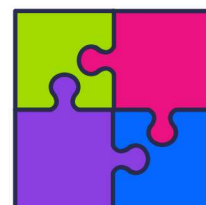
