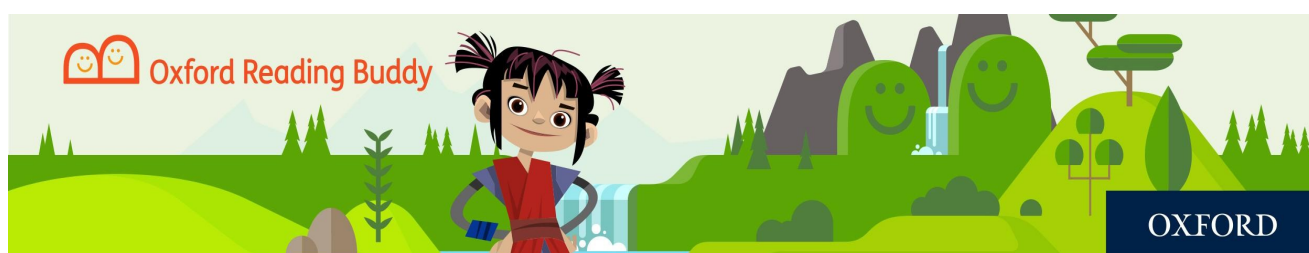
Home Learning

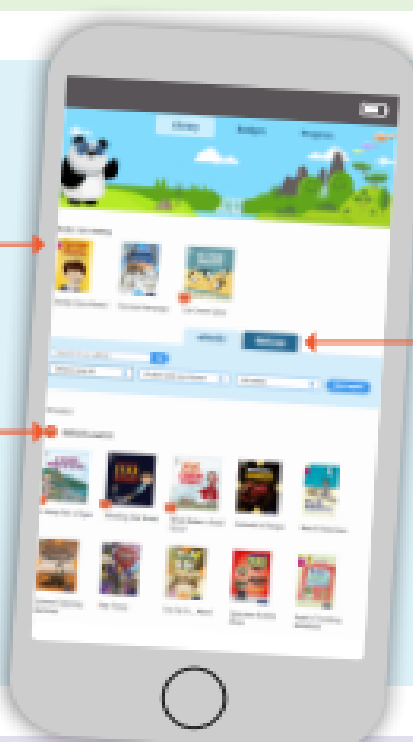

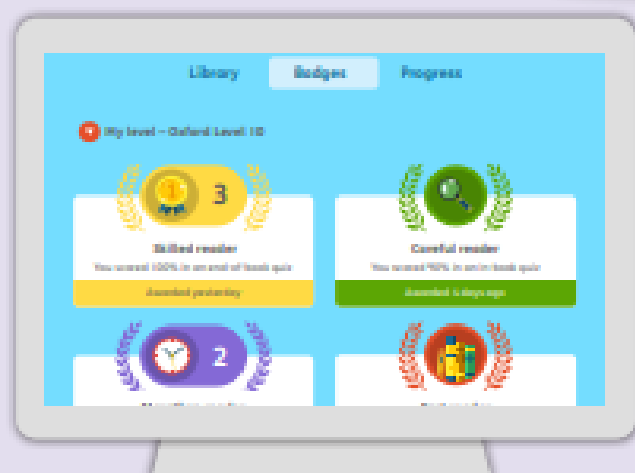

Books with this sign on  are 'Coaching eBooks' and have a buddy to help your child.

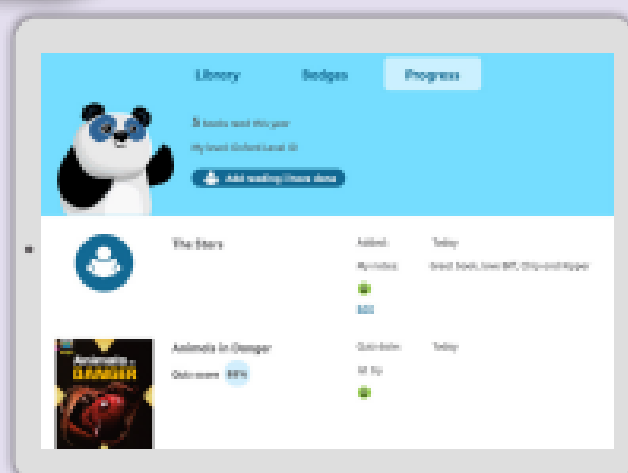

This is where your child's badges are saved. They can earn badges for working hard.

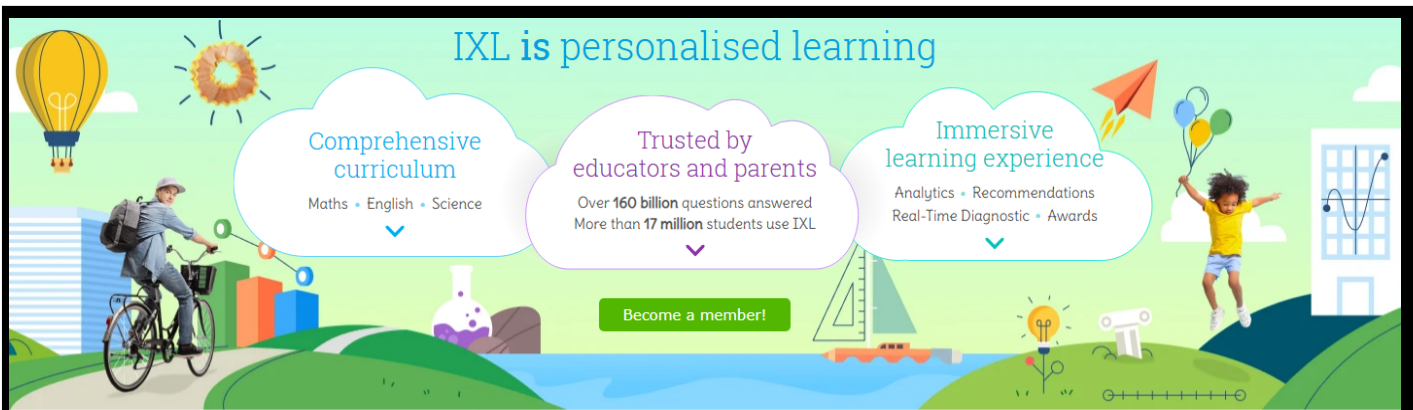
